Winthrop University emeritus professor of computer science. He earned his bachelor's in electrical engineering at the University of New Mexico in 1959. In 2003 he was named recipient of UNM's Outstanding Engineering Alumni award. In 2012, Bresenham was inducted into the Clovis High School "Hall of Honor." His contributions to computer graphics are known as "Bresenham's Algorithms." Bresenham's master's and Ph.D. in industrial engineering are from Stanford University in 1960 & 1964. He holds nine patents.
